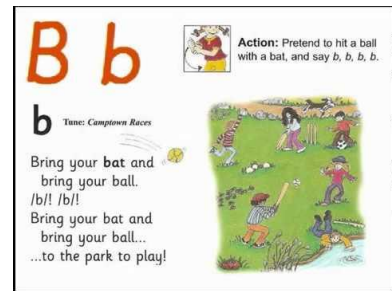
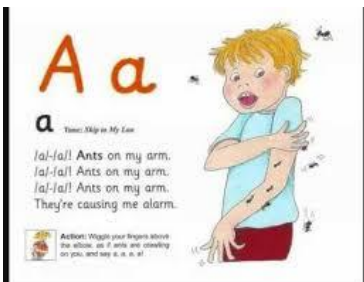




At Swiss Gardens we use Jolly Phonics as our introduction to the sounds we use for reading and spelling.



Jolly phonics is a programme for introducing sounds in English and uses songs and actions to help cement children's understanding.
