# FORTS IN WEST SUSSEX

- There are 2 forts surviving in West Sussex.
- One in Shoreham and one in Littlehampton.

# SHOREHAM FORT

- The exit Adur was getting pushed to the east right in front of Aldrington church.
- In 1628 the French navy gathered ships and went to hunt down to the English harbor.
- The fort in Shoreham **was more expensive than the one in Littlehampton.**



- It took ten men to fire the cannons at Shoreham fort.
- In 1816 the exit Adur stayed put and is where it is today.
- There were water tanks at the base.
- The water tanks carried about 11,578 gallons of water each.
- The base carried 126 barrels of gunpowder.
